



Marine Safety Training Ribbon

The Marine Safety Training Ribbon is awarded in recognition of completion of all educational requirements for the Auxiliary Marine Safety (Trident) device. Once all courses are completed, the member completes an application for award of the ribbon and forwards to their DSO-MS (or other routing if required by their District) as AUXDATA does not automatically notify DIRAUX that the requirements have been met. Course requirements are:

- Good Mate
- Introduction to Marine Safety and Environmental Protection (IMSEP)
- ICS 100
- ICS 200
- Either ICS 210 or ICS 300 (non-CG courses acceptable for ICS 300. ICS 210 is available from CG only.)
- IS 700
- IS 800

Additionally, if the member completes four (4) Marine Safety Performance Qualification Standards and complete 5 years of service in support of Marine Safety missions they are eligible for the award of the Auxiliary Marine Safety (Trident) device.
